### RESOLUTION 2017-02 APPROVAL of the 2015-2040

### METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN (MTP) REVISION #3

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to federal law, the Governor of the State of Texas designated the Harlingen-San Benito Metropolitan Planning Organization (HSBMPO) as the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Harlingen Urbanized area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Harlingen-San Benito Metropolitan Planning Organization is the designated agency for transportation planning in the Harlingen-San Benito metropolitan area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Harlingen-San Benito Metropolitan Planning Organization Transportation Policy Board is currently the forum for cooperative decision-making regarding regional transportation issues; and

**WHEREAS**, the Harlingen-San Benito MPO staff has revised the 2015-2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) due to the following changes:

- Revised the Spur 54 Reconstruction project's CSJ number and moved it to FY 2018 (Harlingen)
- Added the I2/US 83 Turnaround (Eastside) project to FY 2018 (Harlingen)
- Added the FM 506 project to FY 2019 (La Feria)
- Added the I69E/US 77 Ramp Reversal at Loop 499 project to FY 2019 (Harlingen)
- Added the FM 509 project to FY 2019 (Harlingen)
- Modified the FM 509 Extension project and moved the ROW portion to FY 2020 (Harlingen)
- Added the SH 107 project to FY 2020 (Santa Rosa)
- Modified the FM 509 Extension project and moved the construction portion to FY 2021 (Harlingen)
- Added the I69E/US 77/83 at the Lincoln Exit project to FY 2021 (Harlingen)
- Added the Ed Carey Dr/Loop 499 project to FY 2022 (Harlingen)
- Added the I69E/US 77 near Sebastian project to FY 2024 (Cameron County)
- Added the Business 77 project to FY 2022 (San Benito/Harlingen)
- Added the I69E/US 77/83 Northbound project to FY 2026 (San Benito)


**WHEREAS**, the required public comment period commenced on the 12th of September of 2016, and continues for a 30 day public comment period, which will end on the 11th of October of 2016;
