

RESOLUTION 2010-04

**APPROVAL OF THE
2010-2035 METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN (MTP) REVISION # 1**

WHEREAS, the Harlingen-San Benito Metropolitan Planning Organization is the designated agency for transportation planning in the Harlingen-San Benito metropolitan area; and

WHEREAS, the Harlingen-San Benito MPO has reviewed and considered the 2010-2035 MTP Revision #1, which details as follows:

US 77/83 South Parallel Corridor (FM 1479 to FM 509) will be added under the Mobility category in year 2012 and will reflect construction of a 2 lane rural roadway;

US 77/83 South Parallel Corridor (FM 509 to FM 732) will be added in under Mobility category in year 2015;

US 77/83 South Parallel Corridor (FM 1479 to Fm 509) will be added under preliminary engineering and will reflect preliminary engineering for a 4 lane urban roadway;

The San Jose Ranch Road Project (from FM 509 to SH 345) will be moved up to 2019.

Inclusion of On/Off System Bridges Category (for group project purposes);

Addition of missing MTP #s.


Inclusion of BSIF transfer station in Los Indios International Bridge


